The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 29th March, 2023 and is hereby published for general information:—

THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR APPROPRIATION (No. 2) ACT, 2023

No. 6 of 2023

[29th March, 2023.]

An Act to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir for the services of the financial year 2023-24.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India, in exercise of powers vested under the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act, 2019 as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2023.
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir, Issue of Rs. there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one lakh forty-eight thousand five hundred crore rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during Fund of the the financial year 2023-24 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Short title.

148500,00,00,000 out of the Consolidated Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir for the financial year 2023-24.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund Appropriation. of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
